BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

William Y. Wiley was born March 28, 1816 and died January 29, 1873. He married Margaret C. Reck on December 12, 1839. Wiley served as a Captain in the U.S. Army and his civilian jobs included real estate auctioneer, stock broker, commissioner of deeds, and public notary. Gatlin Subdivision was likely located in the present day Babe Denny neighborhood. This neighborhood was located on the near Southside of Indianapolis. Now known as Babe Denny, the north/south and east/west street boundaries for the neighborhood were seen as South to Morris and Madison to West, respectively.

Wiley to Levi Sutherland for lot numbered sixteen of outlot number one hundred and seventeen in the city of Indianapolis in the amount of one thousand dollars. This is likely the northeast corner of Union St. and Ray St., presently located between the 79A and B exit ramps of Interstate 70.
