## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

James S. Parker was a resident of Xenia, Indiana. On February 12, 1865, he enlisted as a Sergeant in Company C of the 151<sup>st</sup> Indiana Volunteer Infantry. He served with the regiment for its entire seven-month tour, mustering out with his comrades in Nashville, Tennessee on September 19, 1865.
