BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Francis Adkinson (1831–1912) was born in Switzerland County, Indiana. He was a lawyer and a judge in Switzerland County. He was later at judge in Ohio County, Indiana, and then a judge in Lawrenceburg, Dearborn County, Indiana. In 1860 he married Frances M. Roberts. Adkinson moved to Helena, Montana, around 1883 where he served as a receiver in the United States Land Office, a position he held until his death.
