## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

Kenesaw M. Landis II (c.1911-1949) was born in Logansport, Indiana. He was the son of Congressman Frederick Daniel and Bessie A. Baker Landis, and nephew of federal judge Kenesaw Mountain Landis and Congressman Charles B. Landis.

He worked as a district prosecuting attorney and headed the law firm Landis, Landis & Miller in Logansport. He also wrote columns in the Chicago Sun and Logansport newspapers. Landis married Anna Louise Landis c.1940 and died on July 12, 1949. His grave is at Mount Hope Cemetery in Logansport, Indiana.
