This summer, join the Institute for Digital Forestry Undergraduate Research Program!

Participants have the opportunity to conduct research within any of the Institute's themes: forest measurement, modeling, extension, and/or education.







During the summer, undergraduate researchers will:

- Conduct research
- Be mentored by Institute faculty and/or fellows
- Participate in professional development workshops
- Present a research poster at the Annual Retreat at the end of the summer

Students will participate in a time intensive research experience the weeks of May 18th-August 3rd and be paid a \$7,000 living allowance, over three installments.
